How to show ip routes in Mac OS X?

Fire up your terminal and enter the following command:

```
netstat -nr
```

Or you could limit it a bit to this:

```
netstat -rnf inet
```

Or maybe you are just looking for the default route:

```
route -n get default
```

For the BSD guys this is easy, but as a Linux user, I was trying route all the time ;)
