## How to rate limiting nginx with X-Forwarded-For header?

If you run nginx behind a load balancer, the external IP of the client will not reach your nginx daemon anymore, so instead of \$binary\_remote\_addr you have to use \$http\_x\_forwarded\_for in your rate limit statement.

Also make sure your load balancer provides this variable!

limit\_req\_zone \$http\_x\_forwarded\_for zone=zone:10m rate=1r/s;
