How to activate TRIM in Mac OS X?

Owners of Macbooks who upgraded to an SSD might want to use this feature and here are two ways to achieve that:

- There is a tool called TRIM Enabler, that does this for you the easy way. Click here.
- For people who want to do it the manual way, here are the shell commands:

sudo cp /System/Library/Extensions/IOAHCIFamily.kext/Contents/PlugIns/IOAHCIBl
ockStorage.kext/Contents/MacOS/IOAHCIBlockStorage /System/Library/Extensions/I
OAHCIFamily.kext/Contents/PlugIns/IOAHCIBlockStorage.kext/Contents/MacOS/IOAHC
IBlockStorage.original

sudo kextcache -system-prelinked-kernel

sudo kextcache -system-caches

These 4 command should do the trick as well.
